- Undertake lifecycle assessment, in relation to the design and selection of materials for use on rolling stock and associated equipment used to deliver customer projects.

- Applying the waste management hierarchy and increasing re-use and recycling.
- Offering employment opportunities, working with local suppliers and actively engaging with the community we are based in, creating partnerships and encouraging volunteering and engagement.
- Embrace new technology and working methods to reduce the need for long distance travel.
- Promote green travel alternatives to all employees, including the availability of electric and hybrid company cars and by selecting hire companies that offer sustainable vehicle solutions.
- Fully investigate any environmental incidents, remedy the damage caused and make necessary changes to help prevent reoccurrence.
- To maintain high standards of compliance, we will ensure all suppliers and sub-contractors utilised are subject to a suitable supplier approval process with periodic reviews, site surveillance/audits as necessary.
- Actively seek to reduce the overall carbon footprint of our business where practicable to do so.
